2010 PARENT ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Meadowbrook Day Camp Tripping Program

1. REFUND POLICY, WITHDRAWALS, AND EARLY DEPARTURES

Due to the seasonal nature of camping, once paid, application deposits, tuition payments, and any fees are non-refundable. There will be no rebate or refund of tuition for late arrival, early withdrawal, or dismissal for cause.

2. RULES AND REGULATIONS

For the safety and welfare of the entire group, campers are not permitted to smoke, or possess tobacco products, illegal drugs or liquor at any time during the program. Violation of this rule, or any other rule listed in the "Camper/Parent Agreement" above, may result in dismissal.

3. HEALTH REPORT

All participants must complete Meadowbrook's Health History Form and submit a doctor's printout stating the date of the last physical (must be within the past year), a complete record of immunizations, allergies, and a statement that there are no restrictions that would limit participation in any activity offered by the Teen Tripping program.

4. LIABILITY RELEASE

I agree to release Meadowbrook Day Camp, its agents and guide services it contracts with, of any and all liability and responsibility of any nature whatsoever and for any loss/damage to property or personal injury incurred during my son's/daughter's participation in the teen tripping program under the direction of the Meadowbrook Day Camp.

Individual organizations that Meadowbrook Day Camp has contracted with to lead a teen trip may also require that its liability release be signed by all parents/guardians.

5. PHOTO RELEASE

I give Meadowbrook Day Camp my permission for graphic images of or statements made by my child to be used in promoting camp activities through advertisements, brochures, videos, web sites, open houses and other promotional events. Names of individuals will not be included. I also give Meadowbrook Day Camp permission to share photos of my child with other members of the teen tripping group.

6. ALTERATIONS IN ITINERARY

Our intention is to follow, as precisely as possible, the itineraries as described on our flyer. However, the order of activities may be changed due to scheduling conflicts, severe weather, or other unexpected situations. In all cases we will do our best to replace an activity or, if necessary, relocate a trip.

7. BUS TRANSPORTATION

Campers enrolled for the rising 6th & 7th grade week may ride the camp buses to and from camp at no additional charge. There will be designated pick-up/drop-off locations in the towns of Lexington, Needham, Newton, Wayland, Wellesley and Weston. However, there may be trips with an earlier departure time and/or later return time that do not coincide with bus schedules. 8. DUE DATES

The health form, individual liability releases, and the balance of tuition payment are due by June 1.
